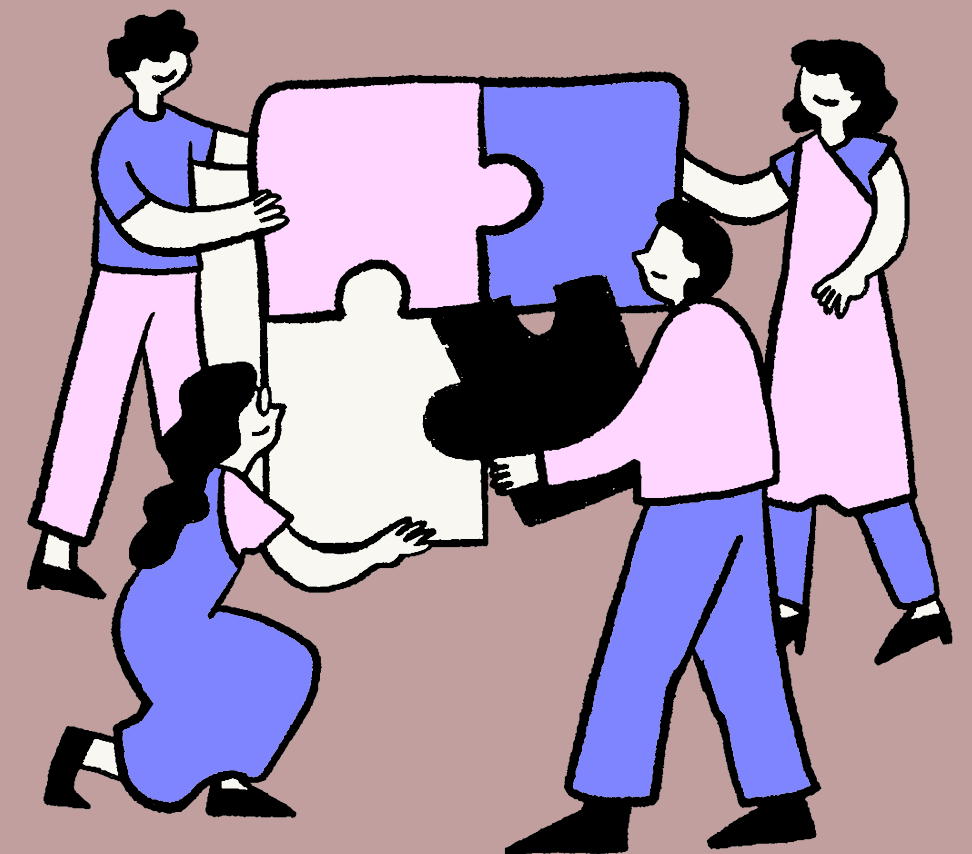
WHAT IS STUDENT COUNCIL ?

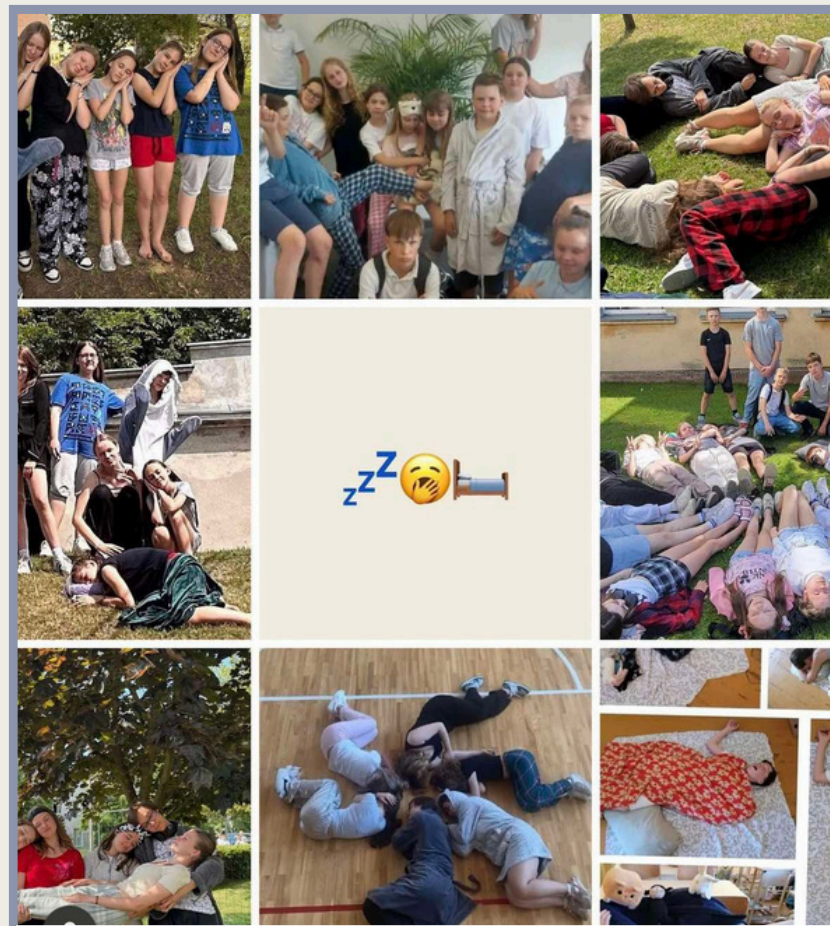
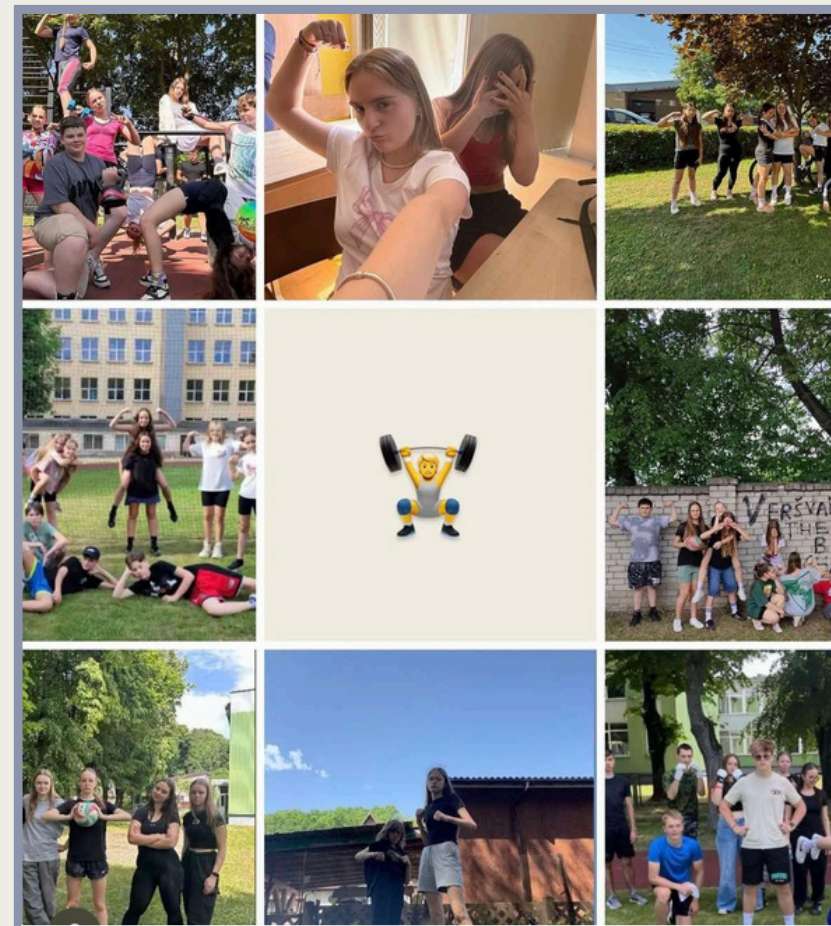
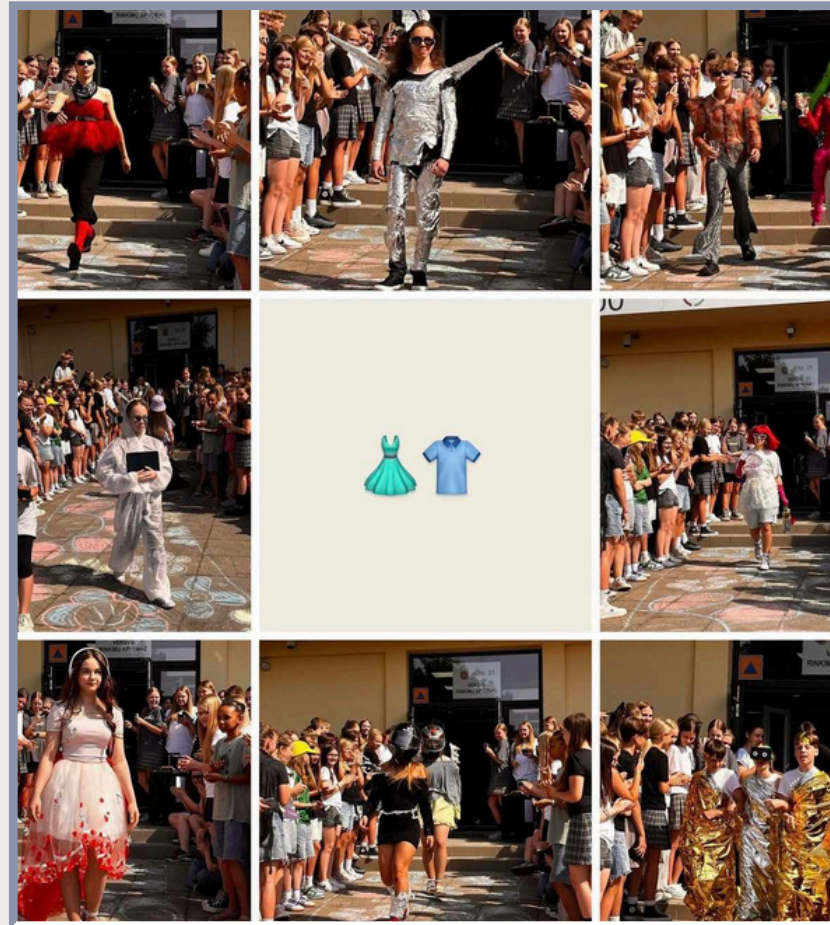
LAST DAY -FASHION SHOW

Points system

Throughout the year, school classes receive points for completed tasks and we count them. At the end of the year, the class that has collected the most points - wins.

They can collect points by taking photos with certain themes, dress codes, decorating doors during events, etc.



Actions and initiatives



- Pie Day (almost 1,700 Euros donated to sick children).
- Don't write it off, support it (We wear different socks to show support for people with Down syndrome).
- No Smoking Day (We encourage people not to use these substances and protect their health).
- A week without bullying (We try to help as much as possible, understand, talk, sympathize...).

Pie day

Pie Day is the most meaningful day when we can contribute to something good and useful. We ask the classes to bake cakes, cupcakes or other sweets.

We sell them and give the profit to sick children.

Last year we managed to collect 1,700 Euros and with that money we either buy something the child dreams of, contribute to treatment, massages, vitamins.



It is important to mention that the student council created the idea of a school uniform and tried to make it a reality and it succeeded



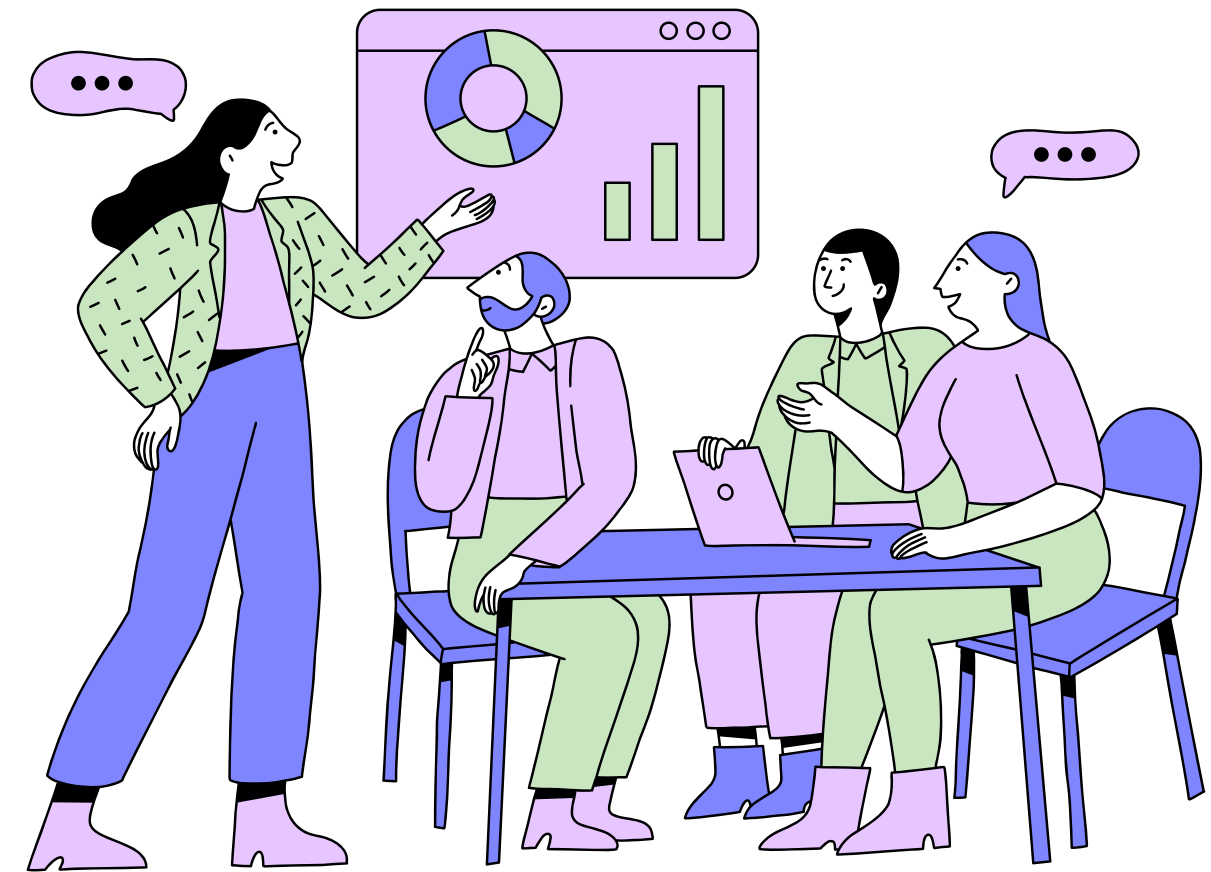
Cooperates

We cooperate with the Lithuanian School Students' Union.

Lithuanian student union public, voluntary, non-profit organization, the only organization representing the interests of Lithuanian schoolchildren and uniting Lithuanian student self-governments. Currently, LMS has 42 branches in Lithuanian municipalities, where more than 1000 volunteers work, the organization unites more than 500 Lithuanian school student municipalities.

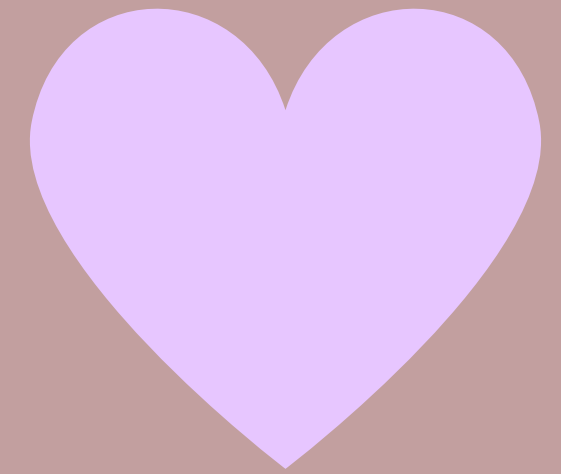


Future plans
